Care and Repair offers free information and advice for older people and people with a disability who are homeowners or private tenants to enable them to improve their homes.

What is Care and Repair?

Care and Repair is a confidential service which provides free information and advice to home owners and private tenants who require improvements, repairs or adaptations to their homes.

Who is Eligible?

If you are elderly or have a disability, or a family member has a disability and you are a homeowner or private tenant, you may be eligible for assistance through Care and Repair.

How can Care and Repair help?

Care and Repair can help by:-

- Organising surveys and drawings
- Obtaining prices for work
- Applying for grants
- Applying for loans or other funding
- Organising the works
- Approaching other agencies

What works can be carried out?

Any works can be considered which are necessary to improve your home. As well as general improvements these could include:-

- New windows and doors
- Re-wiring
- Alterations to suit your needs
- Central Heating
