How to pay your rent

PAYING YOUR RENT

When you signed your tenancy agreement with us you entered into a legal agreement. This means you have various rights and responsibilities. One of these is to pay your rent and any service charges. Your rent goes towards paying for repairs, improvements to your home and other services that we provide to customers.

Rent is due on the first of every month. This means you must pay on or before the first of every month, for the coming month. For instance, you should pay your rent by the 1st May for the month of May.

HOW TO PAY YOUR RENT

Online

Go to www.allpay.net You will need to register your 19 digit account number (found on your Allpay card).

You can pay your rent by

sending a text message (register at allpay.net) or by downloading their app onto your smartphone or tablet.

You can also log into your 'My Cairn' account on our website.

Paypoint

You can use your Allpay payment card at any Paypoint outlet. We can send a new or replacement card if you need one.

Phone

You can phone us to make your payment using your bank card. You can also phone 0844 557 8321, 24 hours a day.

Direct debit

You can set up a direct debit by completing a form and returning it to us. Alternatively, we can set this up for you over the phone.

Chip and pin

If you live in the Highlands we have a chip and pin machine you can use with your bank card.

IF YOU CLAIM HOUSING BENEFIT

Housing Benefit is available to people who are claiming benefits or on a low income to help pay their rent. If you think you might be entitled to Housing Benefit, you should make a claim as soon as you sign your tenancy. Contact your local authority to make an application. Our staff can help you fill in the form if you would like some help.

UNIVERSAL CREDIT

The UK Government has introduced Universal Credit for people who are on a low income, looking for work or working and on a low income. Eventually it will replace many existing benefits, including Housing Benefit.

Visit www.gov.uk/universalcredit to check your eligibility for and to make your claim online. We can help you make your claim if you need it or have trouble accessing the internet. If you receive Universal Credit or Housing Benefit, it is still your responsibility to make sure you pay your rent on time.

RENT ARREARS

Rent arrears are the amount of rent money you owe us. Your rent account will go into arrears if you fail to pay your rent by the date it is due. You can find out what your balance is by contacting your local office.

We know that, from time to time, people can get into financial difficulty. If you find yourself in debt or have difficulty paying your rent, please contact us as soon as possible so that we can give you advice and help, or help you with a benefits claim.

Please remember that having rent arrears may lead to legal action being taken against you. Rent payments have to be a priority to make sure you have a roof over your head.
